


Using request parameters with Smart Templates

With Smart Templates version 1.2 and newer you can pass variables from request to a Smart Template

Here is how:

1. Add a Smart Template to your page




2. Ensure you have checked the option

Edit 'Smart Templates' Macro

<input type="text"/>	Preview
Give your template an identifiable name	
Source	
<input type="button"/>	
Choose the content source you want to reference with this smart template. Leave blank, if you want a macro body to be used as a content source	
<input type="checkbox"/> Hidden Will be hidden on this page, but could be used from other pages	
<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Apply parameters from request URL variables Parameters are prefixed with 'req', meaning that the request parameter with name 'myparam' will be passed as 'reqmyparam'	
Select macro	

3. Then inside the Smart Template you can put something like



4. Then in URL you can do the following

https://wiki.vertuna.com/display/ST/Using+request+parameters+with+Smart+Templates?name=John
```

Hello John

5. And this is the result
6. To sum up - variables from request (URL) can be used within the Smart Template and their names are prefixed with "req". A variable "name" from URL becomes a "\${reqname}" in a template
