


Creating anonymous forms in Confluence with ConfiForms

 Simple way to set your form to capture responses in anonymized form

Quite often there is a need to create a form that gathers anonymous feedback.

By default ConfiForms tracks a user who has created the record in a form and also set's her as a record owner. This is a default behaviour for ConfiForms forms when used on pages which do not allow anonymous access. When anonymous access is an option you can configure your form on such page and enable anonymous records from not-authenticated users, but when a an authenticated user access the form and creates a record her username will be tracked.

Since version 1.9.20 of ConfiForms we have added an additional setting which allows to gather feedback (create records in the form) completely anonymously.

There is a new feature/setting available on ConfiForms Form macro called "**Anonymous form**". And all the records will be created without tracking the createdBy and ownedBy metadata,

Edit 'ConfiForms Form' Macro

☐ **Allow data export**

If you want to enable data export for non-admin users (You will still need to set "Enable export" parameter on the TableView macro)

☐ **Enable form's 'Print' button**

☐ **Show editable fields in Print view**

If un-checked the fields in print view will be shown as read-only labels

Additional usernames (or user groups) that should be treated as form administrators

Comma separated list
