

# Easy employee checklists in Confluence with ConfiForms

**i** ConfiForms is very flexible about how you present your data.

In this tutorial you will learn how to use IFTTT macro to create a simple employee checklist. How to configure inline edit method for your newly created checklist, how to make sure the checklist is secure and visible/editable by an employee and how to see the data in an aggregated way

Let's start with a form configuration. In our example it will have only 4 checklist items and one field to store employee username. All the checklist items are of checkbox field type.

Here is how the form looks like in Confluence editor:

CONFI: ConfiForms Form | formName = chklists | registrationFormTitle = Checklist

The fields for checklist items are with names q1, q2, q3, q4

And in the view mode the form looks like this:

Checklist

Find  Find ConfiForms plugin on the marketplace

Evaluate  Evaluate ConfiForms plugin

The form uses standard UI and might not look as good as you expect.

But it is not important for us and here is why:

- this form is used only by administrators to create new checklists
- an employee never sees the checklist creation UI

So, we need to make some changes to have the checklist look much more beautiful with totally custom L&F

We will achieve this using IFTTT macro which will create a new page with our own, very custom layout and will present checklist items for the employee with explanatory texts and details

Let's add an IFTTT macro to create a page. The macro need to be place inside ConfiForms Form macro and should be hooked up to "On created" event

Insert 'ConfiForms IFTTT Integration Rules' Macro

Event \*  
onCreated

Action to perform \*  
Create Page

Fire IFTTT action only when this condition/filter is met

If empty then IFTTT action is always executed when an event is occurred. Same syntax as in filters

Page title  
Checklist for [entry.employee.name]

Visible only in PREVIEW

How to configure ConfiForms IFTTT macro  
The following fields are defined in the form **chklists** and can be referenced from IFTTT macro body using `$(FIELD_NAME)` or `'[entry.field_name]'` notation.

- id
- createdBy
- ownedBy
- ownedByName
- createdByName
- created
- dateCreatedFormatted
- q1
- q2
- q3
- q4

We create a page with a page title which will be combined with "Checklist for " and the name of the user who's checklist it is. See that user object (employee field) is a complex object and we ask for sub property

When the IFTTT macro is added we need to continue with configuring it's macro body

So, we add ConfiForms Field macros and add some details/layout we need

CONF: ConfiForms IFTTT Integration Rules | event = onCreate | action = Create Page | title = Checklist for [entry.employee.userName...]

**Advanced details:**

1. In current solution, when a checklist is created you need to change the "Owned By" field to the same user name this checklist is created for. As only then this user could change the data in the checklist
2. Also, another security thing to consider is to create pages with IFTTT macro and setting own parent page, in this case you can secure the original form with user permissions and have employee checklist pages separated from it. (This is easily configurable in the IFTTT macro properties (when "Create Page" action is selected))
