

# Using storage format with Confluence cloud

Most of our examples have a complete solution in a storage format. The format that is used by Atlassian Confluence for page (and blogposts) contents storage.

This is the best way to share form configurations and examples

On cloud however, no Source editor is available and we have enabled a feature in ConfiForms app that helps you to import examples we share directly into your page.

This is enabled by your Confluence administrators in ConfiForms app configuration

The feature to enable looks like this

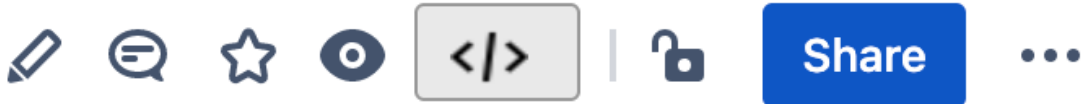
Enable storage format editing
