

Handling Confluence auto-watch when the form has file fields

In ConfiForms you can have forms that accept files from users.

These files are by default attached to the page where the form is defined. And automatically the person who does this becomes the watcher of this page. In most use cases this is not what you want and expect.

To handle this we have introduced a helper IFTTT action called "Remove Page Watcher"

You shall add this to your form definition and the configuration can be as follows

Insert 'ConfiForms IFTTT Integration Rules' Macro

IFTTT macro for ConfiForms. Enables various integrations [Documentation](#)

onCreated

Choose Action to perform *

Remove Page Watcher

Fire IFTTT action only when this condition/filter is met

If left empty then IFTTT action is always executed when an event is occurred. You can use [entry.FIELD_NAME] to reference values of the record. [Same syntax expected as in filters](#)

Page watcher(s) to remove

[entry._user]
